Nearly 100 students met for a citywide Cru High School gathering from 4 Orlando campuses. Lorna ministers at University H.S. as a Cru staff member and as a track coach. Two came to faith in Christ.

Pictured @left below is Lorna speaking to 184 women sharing about the Athletic Training Academy that ministers to H.S. athletes and their families that are homeless or in unstable environments. Twelve women responded to volunteer as either tutors or life skills mentors.







Dirke has been recruiting seminary trained coaches for our Missionary Staff Training Cru holds in January. Dirke helps leads the theological training. We expect record numbers, possibly as many as 200 this January will join Cru. More will join us this summer. Dirke teaches our staff how to study the Bible and how to teach and minister in their ministry contexts. These staff will be sent to all parts of the world. Dirke is also facilitating an online missions class with nine of our new Korean missionary staff ministering in L.A. & NYC.

In addition, Dirke leads Cru's team training for Executive ministry teams. This past week Dirke helped lead two days of workshops with our **Inner-City Executive Team** as they seek to be more effective at ministering to those who are underserved and in serving urban churches who minister in our major cities across the nation.
