Dirke received the above compliment just this past week from one of Cru's U.S. National leadership directors whose team helps equip and influence the nearly 6,000 U.S. Missionary staff who minister around the world. Dirke led a two day workshop that helped them navigate through a variety of team issues that were keeping them from more effectively equipping missionaries to minister to the unreached.

Dirke's strengths of problem solving, relational awareness skills and ministry team experience has been a great fit for Dirke's increased role in leading Cru's Executive team effectiveness training. This fall Dirke has worked with numerous executive teams, including Cru's Inner City team headquartered in the Twin Cities. The first of November Dirke and Cru's National Leadership Development director spent several days at a retreat center in northern MN working with their executive team. Next week Dirke will be working with one of Cru's global leadership teams.

In addition to working with Cru Executive teams, Dirke also leads Cru's Institute of Biblical Studies for new missionary staff. This January we anticipate nearly 150 new missionaries to get theological training.

He Is an advocate for the poor and homeless. God continues to open doors for Lorna as she develops the Athletic Training Academy for urban athletes who are from homeless or distressed environments. She has recently added a man to her board of directors who has worked in several past Presidential administrations.

Pray for the Academy's building development that seeks to house high school athletes and to assist their families to become stabilized within their community. **Pray** for favor as Lorna interacts with Shelley Lauten who is the new director of the homeless commission. Lorna is hoping Shelley will help her meet some of the needs among our homeless high school students that are falling through the gap. **Pray** that Lorna continues to share the gospel as she meets with high school students each week, city officials and community leaders.

Lorna will also be ministering at the Impact Conference in Atlanta at the end of the month. Impact is a ministry that reaches African American college, high school and young adults with the gospel and equips them to spread God's word in their spheres of influence. Pray God brings all who He wants there and that lives will be impacted for Christ.
