In God's sovereignty, He has already allowed me to exercise many of the skill-sets necessary to see this vision become reality.

In Minneapolis, before focusing with the Impact Movement, I was the president of a neighborhood association that operated a million dollar plus budget. I coordinated working with the mayor, police and city services. While there and in Orlando, I became a certified track coach that produced state champions and was asked to do track clinics across the city. The last three years as Impact's Associate National Campus Director, I have learned skills to mobilize, train and develop ministry workers on a broad scope. Now I have the opportunity to expand my skills, training, and my heart to live out the gospel in an even greater capacity. *This is a faith jump!*
