TALK TO GOD ABOUT EVERYTHING

At our church, Dirke recently preached on *Philippians 4:6 – Don't be anxious about anything, pray about everything*. The apostle Paul says talk to God and quit trying to figure it out in your own wisdom. Whatever is a concern to you is a concern to God. *Psalms 138:8 – The Lord will accomplish what concerns you.* There is nothing too small or too large for God. Since God knows everything, why should I pray and tell Him something He already knows? **First, let me share two reasons we DON'T talk to God:**

We don't pray to impress God.

There is nothing we can say or how we say it that will impress God. In fact, Jesus says we are to pray to God like a child. Jesus is the first one to pray "Abba Father." Abba is Aramaic for the term a little child uses to speak to their daddy.

• We don't pray to inform God. You can't tell God anything He doesn't already know.

If we don't pray to impress or inform God, why then do we pray?

We pray to invite God into our lives. When we pray we experience:

- Strengthening of our Relationship We become workers together with what God is doing around us and with those things that concern us. *He could do it without us, but we could never do it without Him.* What a glory that God allows us the privilege of doing it *with* Him!
- **Spiritual Growth** Have you ever prayed and then began asking yourself, why do I want this? Is this a selfish request? What might God want? We develop discipline & staying power and grow our faith when we pray.
- **Dependency on God** God doesn't want you to live life independent of Him. He wants you to experience His continual provision. Your continual prayer instills a habit of dependency on God rather than yourself.
